#### Logline

Three sisters scam their father's gold-digging girlfriend to regain their mother's rightful inheritance. Then frame her for murder when they discover she killed their father.

### Sister Stuff

#### Pitch

First Wives Club meets Gaslight meets Sylvia Silverman.

SYLVIA SILVERMAN and her three grown daughters had no idea that strange, estranged husband IRV SILVERMAN was even sick. They find out he died when the postman hands them his will. It leaves everything to his girlfriend MARNIE. He had promised Sylvia he'd leave everything to her if she didn't contest their divorce. The girls determine to keep his promise. They gaslight the gold-digger into believing she must bury the money or it will bring her increasingly bad luck. They dig it up. During the victory celebration, they find out she murdered their dad. Took him dancing the night he rewrote his will, two weeks after a stroke. But it's impossible to prove. Their scheme to frame her requires them to return the money they just won back. Their plan backfires. Jail. A new plan. They discover she's a serial widow. They follow the money. She's wanted by the IRS for tax evasion. IRS agents uncover her previous identities, and a string of dead husbands. A murderer can't benefit from her crime, so Irv's estate is returned to his daughters -- who bequeath it to their mother.
